Please arrange to pick up your child/ren from their S.S. class each week or let teacher know it is O.K. for him/her to leave the room by self. This is for safety reasons.

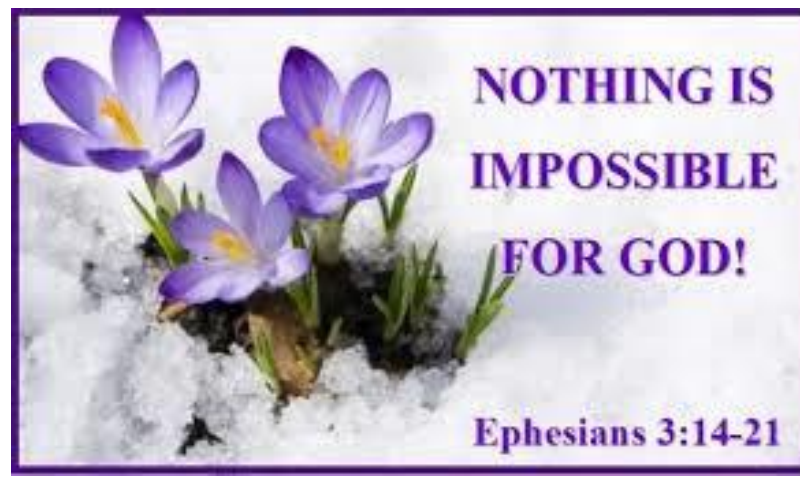
